PRO AM EVENTS WILL BE HELD ON SATURDAY EAST COAST CLASSIC EVENTS ON SUNDAY

Official Closing Date Friday 13th October 2017

Late entries may be accepted up to Friday 20th October 2017 subject to the payment of the Late Entry Fee of \$25 per couple in addition to the quoted Entry/Admission Fees.

Dances are the same as the 2017 Australian Championship

Open events lesser number of dances may be danced in the rounds through to semi final.

All couples can dance up an age - Juvenile may dance Junior. Junior may also dance Youth. Youth may dance Adult.

Masters I may dance down to Adult, Masters II may dance down to Masters I, Masters III may dance down to Masters II in all styles however they **MUST** pre enter these events when placing their entry online.

Grand Masters - this event has been added in the program for couples where both members of the partnership are at least 65 years old. Grand Masters can also dance in Masters III events.

The organisers reserve the right to cancel or combine any events with less than 4 couples entered.

Open events are open to all levels.

Recreational competitions are for dancers registered with DSA, they may also dance in the Solo girl/boy events if they wish as this is a novelty event.

Recreational Individual is for dancers who are not competing in couple events, they can be partnered by another recreational or graded partner but **NOT** by a coach, they may also dance in the Solo girl/boy events. Juvenile individual may also dance Junior.

Solo Girl or Boy events are for dancers who are not competing in couple events, they do not need to be registered with DSA.

Individual and Social Couple events - are for dancers not registered with DSA, dancers can dance in the Social Couple, Individual and Solo girl/boy events, .

Programming the event will be run in sections with progressive presentations to allow for shorter attendance times for all competitors.

1st round times will be posted on the website and the society Facebook at least one week prior to the event.

Parking - plenty of parking available at and close to the venue.

No entries will be accepted on the day
