GENERAL INFORMATION

Open events These events are Open to all grades, Dances may be deleted in early rounds of the Open events if required.

No entries will be accepted on the day. Please ensure you enter online all events you wish to compete in. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or combine any events with less than 4 pre-entries. Events with no pre-entries in may be cancelled.

Entries ALL entries are to be done on line at: www.p5000 admission tickets can be purchased using the ticket order form. Reserved seating is only available for pre purchased tickets in studio blocks based on ticket sales.

Presentations - Juvenile, Junior and Youth events will be finalized and presented early.

Conducted under the rules and regulations of Dancesport Australia and the Australian Dancing Society

Dancing up Age Groups - All couples may dance up to the next age group in addition to their own age section with the exception of Masters who would dance down an age group. This will allow all couples the opportunity to have plenty of events to compete in. If an event has no couples entered in the age group event it will be cancelled and not run for couples dancing out of their own age group.

Non Registered Events are for competitors who are not registered with DSA. There are couple events in addition to individual events. All non registered dancers may dance in both the couple and individual event. Individuals may be partnered by another individual or a registered amateur dancer who does not take them for private lessons. Separate events will be run for boy and girl individuals if required.

Solo Events - are for dancers without partners, These events are novelty events so the participants do not require to be registered however registered recreational dancers who are not

competing in the couples events on the day may also dance. Depending on entries they will be separated into separate Boy and Girl events.

Recreational Individual - events are for registered recreational dancers who are not competing on the day with a partner, under DSA rules they must be partnered by another recreational dancer. Separate events will be run for boy and girls if required.

Masters competitors must choose to dance Masters I or Masters II/III for the entire program. If insufficient entries are received in any style the Masters I and Masters II events may be combined.

Coach/Student Amateur coach and Professional coach events have been included in the program, in each style, each teacher can dance with one student in each event. These events will be held in the Adult/Masters session.

Scheduled Event times will be available via the ADS Facebook page and dancesportlive the week prior to the event.
